“J T has gone to be with the Lord”, M told me plainly. Apparently he and three other government officials had a car wreck and all but one died in the ensuing flames. Such a tragedy in so many ways. From a selfish standpoint, he was M’s best friend and a proven fundraiser for LBNF in J, Nigeria. He was also the father of five children and was taking care of one of M’s sons. He was the one who was told by a prophet to find a one-armed evangelist named M from M. I asked the Lord about this, and He told me we were caught up in looking to man to meet our needs and not Him. Not that this was the reason behind his death, but rather this was the lesson we were to take away from it. T is gone and who will step up in Nigeria?

Yesterday, I spoke to Ambassador M from Nigeria. He informed me he would make good on a pledge he made when I was there in June to donate to LBNF. Since M needed the money to pay off half his debt when he fixed the 4x4 involved in a bad wreck, he agreed to send it directly to him. I also asked him to prayerfully consider being a networker and fundraiser for the men working in Nigeria, the men of LBNF. He is considering it.

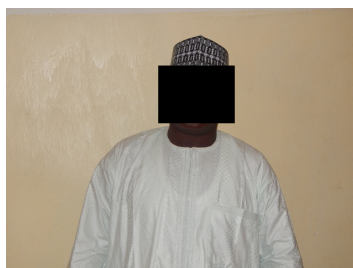

Speaking of the work, I want to mention where we are in our strategic plan for the next five years. Burkina Faso as I mentioned before is surrounded by six countries in West Africa. Very poor but somewhat stable, former French colony, I believe this is the next “center” for our ministry in the Middle Province of West Africa. I will have access to many unreached muslim villages in the region, without quite the expense and distance of travel we normally have to deal with.

By the grace of God we have a contact, the Director of Deeper Life Ministries of BK, his name is Pastor E. A very gracious man who has agreed to help us with nothing more than the knowledge that I worked with his friend Pastor B in Chad. He will sponsor us and assist us with putting together

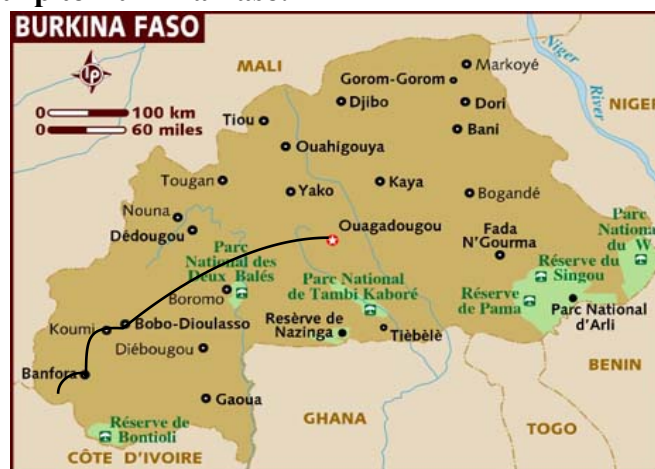
a team in BK. From the capital of Ouagadougou we (D; our interpreter, and myself), intend to fly west to Bobo Dialouso to possibly meet future members of our team. Then we will rent a vehicle to take us to B, look for an interpreter who speaks Jula and French, then if the Holy Spirit opens the door, proceed southwest to the villages of the B. An unreached people group in the area. Your mission if you choose to accept it, is to pray for us, for the Lord to pick the team for us to work with into the future, for the Lord to continue to protect us and provide for our mission, and of course that there would be open doors for us to preach Jesus among the unreached muslim villages where we go.
