Please Help Me Reach the Zenega of Senegal

Look at the passage above and read the next few verses. As seen in the John account, Judas and some of the other disciples reacted negatively to what this woman (Mary sister of Lazarus), did for Jesus. The Lord told them to leave her alone for she did a good thing for Him preparing His body for burial. What did the disciples want to do with the money? Judas wanted to steal it, others wanted just to give it to the poor. Jesus said, the poor you always have with you and you can always do good to them, but Me you do not always have with you. My question to you, which the Lord has also asked of me, who ministered to Jesus? Mary of course. To whom did the disciples (and also I), want to minister? The poor, the lost, everyone but Jesus. Ouch.

The Lord has shown me that my focus has been on other things rather than Him. I have been investing in great opportunities and your money has won over 37,000 unreached muslims to Christ so far this year. My heart however has been on ministry first and not the personal needs of my gracious God and Savior. Well, Okay. No problem really, it just takes the revelation of God and a decision to refocus my love and heart on Him, which is called repentance. Done. Have my efforts diminished for reaching the lost? So you know, no man receives this kind of equipment until he leads another to Christ. Today I found out he has led 3 to Christ. Rashid will receive his. Another of the “four” is also asking for a megaphone.

Prince has returned from the Kebbi state (NW Nigeria) where he has seen over 1,500 Fulani and other ethnic groups I have personally not heard of, come to Jesus. In one village an old woman (pictured here), took in the team of evangelists after they preached and the rains came. He led her, her daughter and her daughter's kids to Christ. Wonderful. Because of a few gifts we were able to send Joel into the bush of NW Benin to minister the gospel to the Dendi there. Because of the generosity of one of you, we are able to send Ali, Javed and Aayan (chief from the Zarma of Ghana), to NW Ghana to preach to 9,000 Chakali located in seven villages. The only known area for this ethnic group. I predict the major outpouring of the HS.

The map to the right depicts Senegal. There are an estimated 500 Zenega living near Louga. A small number of people who Jesus cares for deeply. I am asking the Father, and I also ask you to facilitate our mission there in October. It will entail extensive recon and resources to “make this happen”. I believe we will do it, with His Presence of course. Hallelujah!
